What are Hunts?

A hunt is a shared, real-time experience where players or teams work through a curated list of items they must find, photograph, or record live within the app. Hunts can be lighthearted and collaborative—or they can be fully competitive, with teams racing to finish the list faster than others.

Most hunts include a host, who approves submissions, sets the rules, and manages the flow of the game. Because everyone is participating at the same time, hunts create a fun, energetic environment that works great for families, parties, classrooms, and team-building events.

Each team ends the hunt with its own recap video, automatically created from their completed items—perfect for sharing, comparing, or reliving the experience. Hunts bring people together, whether the goal is friendly competition or simply completing the adventure as a group.

What are Quests?

A quest is a personal, self-paced adventure designed for someone who wants to explore, capture moments, and complete items on their own terms. Unlike hunts, quests don't require a host, and no approvals are needed—everything is driven by the player's own progress and creativity.

Quests are perfect for bucket lists, travel goals, museum visits, family outings, sightseeing, or long-term adventures like visiting all 30 MLB stadiums. Players can complete items in any order, over any length of time, and even upload photos or videos directly from their device's gallery.

Because quests are flexible and fully controlled by the creator, each one becomes a personalized journey. When the player finishes, Scavengertime automatically builds a recap video that highlights their unique experience—an easy way to save, share, or relive the adventure.
